# **Pastoral Team's Report:**

Fr. Mike and Bro. Paul reported:

- Bro. Paul reported Mass attendance numbers for November and December.
- December attendance was slightly lower than November with an average of 97 at the 8:30 Mass and 111 at the 11:00 Mass.
- 276 people attended the Christmas Eve 4:00 PM Mass.
- We continue to see new people in church.
- We want to promote the Catholic Ministries collection. Commitment Sunday is February 5.
- We will be hosting a staff lunch for the S-8 Beacons of Light family staff on Wednesday, February 1. It is an effort to stay connected to our family of parishes in light of being independent.
- We are excited to have Bro. Tom Redman with us on Saturday, January 21 for the Everything Marianist program.
- We plan to do a volunteer appreciation lunch on Saturday, February 18 from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM.

### **Parish Finance Report**

John Mitchell reported that year to date the parish is close to budget.

- CISE funding is helping with the school budget.
- The 2023/24 budget planning starts in January.

## **Calvary Cemetery**

- Bro Paul reported he spoke with Larry Pauly who was president of board. Jack Boyle is the current board president.
- Calvary Cemetery has its own board independent of the parish although there are members of SFDS parish on the board.
- The parish does not have jurisdiction over the Calvary Cemetery board.

- They are looking at various projects for temporary fencing and repairing/replacing the Duck Creek wall that was hit by a truck.
- They are operating with a small endowment and limited resources at this time.

John Bruening reported the Archdiocese of Cincinnati will provide \$250,000 for the Steeple repair. John is meeting with another contractor that specializes in church Steeple repairs to get another bid.

# **Sound System Update**

John Bruening reported that not all of the equipment for the audio and video streaming upgrades have been received yet due to supply chain issues.

### **Clock Light Repair**

John Bruening reported that he repaired the light that was out on the steeple clock.

# **Plaster Repair**

Phase 1 of the interior ceiling repair stared on January 17.

### **Parish Directory**

Holly Schwein reported the parish directories are available to members that got a photo taken or provided a photo. Members have access to an app. Holly will get the link to the app for members to download.

## **Social Justice Fund**

John Mitchell reported the 6 service agencies were invited to apply for the Social Justice Fund. 5 of the 6 agencies submitted applications. Grants will be awarded in the May timeframe.
